Zika Virus

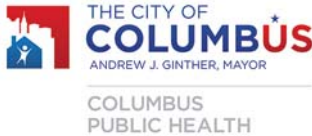
Columbus Public Health has confirmed the first Zika case in a Columbus resident, a 38 year old non-pregnant woman who recently returned from travel to Dominican Republic. The case initially experienced 103°F fever, rash, arthralgia and conjunctivitis, but has since recovered.

Healthcare providers are encouraged to submit specimens to Ohio Department of Health Laboratory (ODHL) from symptomatic individuals, as well as asymptomatic pregnant women, who have traveled to Zika-affected countries.
